Coronavirus Spring Update

Based upon the latest information the club has updated the club's **Coronavirus polices** to the Following:

- **1.**Face Mask are required inside the clubhouse (including the restrooms) and whenever you are less than 6 feet from people not in your party.
- 2. Clubhouse is limited to 25 people. One front sliding door and the rear sliding door must be open while building is occupied. It is okay to run the heater with the doors open. Mask are still required when you are unable to social distance from people not in your party.
- **3.** No organized or pop-up events until things change.

The Board cannot stress enough that it is **everyone's responsibility** to keep one

another safe and be respectful of one another's space.
