### Coronavirus Update

Below is just a refresher of what we all need to be doing in order to prevent the spread of Coronavirus.

Based upon the latest information the club has updated the club's **Coronavirus polices** to the following:

1. Face Mask are required inside the clubhouse (including the restrooms) and whenever you are less than 6 feet from people not in your party.
2. The clubhouse should only be used for the restroom and kitchen facilities. All food consumption should occur outside.
3. Guests are welcome when accompanied by a member. Please be mindful of the club policy.
4. All members must maintain 6 feet from other members visiting the club
5. No organized or pop-up events

The Board can't stress enough that it is **everyone's responsibility** to keep one another safe and be respectful of one another's space.
